

Conditions of Use: Courtesy Trailers

- If you are using the trailer to move goods in to storage, your storage agreement must be completed and storage fees paid prior to collecting the trailer. The payment must be cleared funds no cheques.
- The Driver of the Enclosed trailer must not be on P1 (Red P plates) type License as per NSW Transport regulations related to braked trailers.
- The trailer can be used for bringing goods into and out of Hi-Tech Self Storage **only**, not for any other use AND is to be used within the local area only (call to confirm).
- The trailer must be **collected between 8:00am and 8.30am ONLY** on the day.
- The trailer **must be returned and emptied before 4:00pm Monday to Friday and by 12.00pm Saturday. (Not available Public Holidays)**
- The Driver and Storer are responsible for any traffic infringements and excesses on Insurance Claims while they are using the trailer.
- **Management reserves the right to breathalize or deny the use of the trailer to anyone suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or for any other reason.**
- **No Pets or livestock of any sort are allowed in the trailer.**
- You need to provide your own rope, blankets or anything else you may need to secure your load.

As our courtesy trailers are very popular, we ask that you advise us immediately if you are unable to comply with any of these conditions or no longer require our courtesy trailer, so we can make it available to other customers.
